

CHAPTER 7
BUILDING INSPECTOR.

- 1-7-1: Appointment. There is hereby created the position of Building Inspector, who shall be appointed by the President by and with the advice and consent of the Board of Trustees.
- 1-7-2: Duties. It shall be the duty of the Building Inspector to see to the enforcing of all ordinance provisions relating to building, electricity, plumbing and zoning and to inspect all buildings or structures being erected or altered, as frequently as may be necessary to insure compliance with the Village ordinances.
- 1-7-3: Stop Order. The Building Inspector shall have the power to order all work stopped on construction, alteration or repair of buildings in the Village when such work is being done in violation of any provision of any ordinance relating thereto or in violation of the zoning ordinance. Work shall not be resumed after the issuance of such an order except on the written permission of the inspector, provided, however, that if the stop order is an oral one, it shall be followed by a written stop order within an hour.
- Such stop order may be served by the Building Inspector or by any policeman.
- 1-7-4: Entry Powers. The Building Inspector shall have the power to make or cause to be made an entry into any building or premises where the work of altering, repairing or constructing of any building or structure is going on, for the purpose of making inspections, at any reasonable hour.
- 1-7-5: Duties. It shall be the duty of the Building Inspector to see to the enforcement of all provisions of the ordinances relating to plumbing and plumbing equipment, and to make such inspections and perform such tests as may be necessary in the enforcement of such ordinances.
- 1-7-6: Powers. The Building Inspector shall have the right during reasonable hours to enter any building in the discharge of his official duties, or for the purpose of making an inspection or test of the electrical equipment therein; and he shall have the authority to enforce all the ordinance provisions relating to electrical wiring and equipment. He shall have the power to cause the current in any wire or conduit to be turned off whenever this becomes necessary for the protection of life or limb, or property.
- 1-7-7: Inspections. The Building Inspector shall make all inspections necessary to see the enforcement of the ordinances relating to electricity; and no electric wiring shall be covered until it has been inspected and approved.

- 1-7-8: Certificate. The Building Inspector shall give a certificate of approval to the owner or person in charge of the premises which he has inspected where he finds that the electrical apparatus and wiring therein fully comply with the ordinances of the Village.
- 1-7-9: Compensation. The Village Building Inspector shall receive compensation in the amount of Twelve and 50/100's Dollars (\$12.50) per hour for those hours of work authorized by the Board of Trustees.
