

CHAPTER 8
DIRECTOR OF VILLAGE MAINTENANCE

[2003 AMENDMENT]

- 1-8-1: Office Created. There is hereby created the office of Director of Village Maintenance, an executive office of the Village. Said Director shall be appointed from nominations by the President or Board of Trustees, or both, and shall assume office upon a majority vote. In addition, the Director of Village Maintenance shall be required to attend at least one Village Board meeting per month, but more frequently if so requested by the President and/or Board of Trustees. The Director of Village Maintenance shall be paid Twelve and 50/100's Dollars (\$12.50) per hour for any hours worked on behalf of the Village.
- 1-8-2: Streets. The Director of Village Maintenance shall have charge of the construction, repair and maintenance of all public Village streets, alleys, and cul-de-sacs and the ditches and culverts within same.
- 1-8-3: Lighting. The Director of Village Maintenance shall supervise the operation, repair, and maintenance of the lighting of the public Village streets, alleys and cul-de-sacs.
- 1-8-4: Utilities. The Director of Village Maintenance shall be the Village's official representative in matters relating to Com Ed, NICOR, SBC, and Holiday Hills Utilities (the Village's current utility for water supply), or their respective successors and assigns, and such Director shall be the liaison to such utilities in matters relating to maintenance, repair, and/or improvement of such respective utility system in order to maintain the safe, efficient, and healthy operation of said utilities and the quality of the service provided to the Village by each of said utilities.
- 1-8-5: Property. The Director of Village Maintenance shall be the custodian of all property of the Village which is not assigned to the care or custody of any other officer.
- 1-8-6: Other Duties. The Director of Village Maintenance shall perform such other duties and responsibilities as may be assigned by the President and/or Board of Trustees from time to time, in addition to those duties as set forth above in this Chapter.
