

CHAPTER 7
USE OF VILLAGE PROPERTY

- 2-7-1: Vehicles: No person, other than authorized personnel, shall bring or use any motorized vehicle, including but not limited to any automobile, truck, recreational vehicle, snowmobile, motorcycle, motor scooter, motorized bicycle, go-cart, golf cart or lawn mower, upon any portion of any Village property except in designated parking areas. This Subsection shall not apply to public highways, streets and alleys which are regulated by other provision of this Chapter.
- 2-7-2: Offering Articles for Sale: No person shall offer or exchange for sale any article or thing, or do any hawking, peddling, or soliciting, or buy or offer to buy an article or thing, or take up any collection, or solicit to receive contributions of money or anything of value on any Village street or road or any other Village property, except when authorized to do so by permit from the Village Board of Trustees.
- 2-7-3: Public Meetings: No person shall call or hold any public meeting or give any concert or public entertainment of any kind on any Village property without express consent of the Village Board of Trustees.
- 2-7-4: Restricted Areas: No person shall enter upon any portion of any Village property where persons are prohibited from going by direction of any officer or employee of the Village as indicated by sign or notice.
- 2-7-5: Sleeping on Village Property: No person shall sleep on any Village property between ten o'clock (10:00) p.m. and sunrise, except when authorized to do so by permit from the Village Board of Trustees or its designate.
- 2-7-6: Tents and Trailers: No person shall use on any Village property any tent, camp trailer, mobile home, the like or any other temporary dwelling, residence or structure except by permit from the Village Board of Trustees.
- 2-7-7: Fires: No person shall light or make use of any fire on any Village property, unless authorized to do so by a Village official.
- 2-7-8: Dumping: No person shall deposit, dump, throw, or place any rubbish, including clippings of trees, shrubs or grass, or junk of any kind, in or upon any part of any Village property. Paper, garbage, or refuse matter shall not be so deposited except in receptacles provided for that purpose.
- 2-7-9: Advertisements: No person shall display any placard or advertisement of any kind on any Village property, or right of way nor shall any person cast, throw or place any handbill, pamphlet, circular, advertisement, notice of any kind, nor post, stencil, or otherwise affix any notice, or bills, advertisements, or other papers, upon any structure or thing in or about any Village property, or right of way.

- 2-7-10: Protection of Birds and Animals: No person shall trap, catch, wound, or treat cruelly, or attempt to trap, catch, wound, or kill any bird or animal, or to molest or rob any nest of any bird or animal on any Village property, providing, however, trapping may occur when authorized by a permit or license issued by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources.
- 2-7-11: Damage to Village Property: No person shall cut, break, climb on, or in any way deface any tree, shrub, plant, turf, or any buildings, fences or bridges, lamps, posts, signs or any other structure on any Village property.
