

CHAPTER 5
LITTER CONTROL

[FROM ORD. 90-12]

4-5-1: Definitions: For purposes of this Chapter, the following words shall have the meanings ascribed to them, unless the context otherwise requires:

LITTER	has the meaning as ascribed to it in Section 86-3 of the Illinois Litter Control Act
MOTOR VEHICLE	has the meaning as ascribed to it in Section 1-146 of the Illinois Vehicle Code
PERSON	means any individual, partnership, firm, copartnership, company, corporation, association, joint stock company, trust, estate, or any other legal entity or their legal representative, agent or assigns
RESIDENT	means a person residing within the Village of Holiday Hills, Illinois
LICENSED REFUSE HAULER	means any person engaged in the business of the collection, hauling and disposal of refuse and so licensed and registered by the State

4-5-2: Violations and Exceptions: This Section does not apply to gardening or recycling practices, including but not limited to mulching, planting, fertilizing, composting, and other practices associated with nurturing the growth of flora or those to assist in the recycling of litter.

- A. No person may store or abandon, dump, discard, or deposit or cause to be stored or abandoned, dumped, discarded or deposited any litter anywhere within the Village except in appropriate refuse receptacles, cans, boxes, bags, or similar closed refuse containers.
- B. No resident shall dispose of their litter except via licensed refuse haulers.
- C. The placement by residents of appropriate refuse containers shall be adjacent to the resident's access driveway on the parkway and then not before 7:00 P.M. on the evening before the day of collection by a licensed refuse hauler and said containers shall be retrieved by the resident within 24 hours after their placement as required herein.
- D. The burning of raw garbage which produces nauseous, noxious or offensive odors, or which produces undue smoke, on any lands within the Village is prohibited.
