

CHAPTER 1
ILLINOIS VEHICLE CODE

5-1-1: Illinois Vehicle Code:

There is hereby adopted by reference the following provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/1-100 et. seq., as same may be amended from time to time, the same being a public record of the State, subject to additions, amendments or modifications hereinafter set forth. Citations referring to this Chapter shall be preceded by the number of this Chapter and then shall be followed by a reference to the appropriate section of this Chapter or the Illinois Vehicle Code, where applicable.

The following provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code are hereby expressly adopted by reference:

- (a) Chapters 1, 3, 4, 6, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 in their entirety, as they may be amended from time to time;
- (b) Excluded from adoption by reference and hereby deleted are Chapters 2, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 17, 18 and the Miscellaneous Laws of the Illinois Vehicle Code except as specified above.

The following amendment, modifications and/or additions are hereby made in the provisions in the Illinois Vehicle Code otherwise herein adopted by reference: “State” and “Department” shall mean the “Village of Holiday Hills”, provided, however, that the Village does not assume any power or authority which, by law, can only be undertaken by the State or the Illinois Department of Transportation. It is not intended that any penalty for a violation of this Chapter exceed that which is permitted by law. To the extent such amendments, modifications and/or additions or any other provisions of this Chapter are inconsistent with the provision of the Illinois Vehicle Code herein adopted, the more restrictive and specific regulation shall apply, but otherwise this Chapter shall be so construed as to favor the effectiveness of the regulations and intent of the Illinois Vehicle Code. Except as otherwise expressly specified herein, the words and phrases used herein shall have those meanings respectively ascribed to them in the Illinois Vehicle Code.

5-1-2: Specific Penalties:

Every person convicted of violating any provision of Section 5-1-1 of this Chapter (the Illinois Vehicle Code as incorporated by reference herein by the foregoing section) shall be punishable by one or more of the following dispositions as are authorized for such offense by reference to the Illinois Vehicle Code and as may be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction:

- (a) A minimum fine of \$75 shall be assessed for all offenses except for operation with a certificate of safety as that offense is defined by 625 ILCS 5/13-111(b) in which case the minimum fine assessed shall be \$250, up to a maximum fine as authorized by reference to the Illinois Vehicle Code;
- (b) A term of incarceration, either periodic or continuous, in a penal institution other than the penitentiary for a period not to exceed three hundred sixty-four (364) days as authorized by reference to the Illinois Vehicle Code; and/or
- (c) A term of supervision or conditional discharge as authorized by reference to the Illinois Vehicle Code and the Illinois Unified Code of Corrections; and/or
- (d) Mandatory community service; and/or
- (e) Such other disposition as authorized by reference to the Illinois Vehicle Code.
