

## CHAPTER 5

### MECHANICAL CODE

7-5-1: Adopted

A certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the Village Clerk of the Village, and which have been on file therein for a period of thirty (30) days prior to the adoption of this Chapter, being marked and designated as the "BOCA Basic Mechanical Code, 1990 Edition, as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc.", be and is adopted as Chapter 5 of this Title, for the control of buildings and structures as provided in this Chapter; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of the BOCA Basic Mechanical Code, 1990 Edition, are referred to, adopted and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this Chapter, with the following additions, deletions, insertions and changes:

1. The words "Village of Holiday Hills" should be inserted in the second line of Section M-100.1 on page 1 of the Code.
2. Delete the provisions of Sections M-109.3 and insert the following provision as and for Section M-109.0:

"Section M-109.0. Enforcement Officer. It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Village Inspector to enforce the provisions of the Mechanical Code. The Building Inspector is herein referred to as the Mechanical Official."
3. Section M-114.2, Periodic inspections, shall read as follows:

"All fees for periodic inspections shall be the same as the fees charged for building permits as indicated in Section 114.3.1 of the BOCA Basic Building Code, Eleventh Edition, 1990 hereinafter set forth."
4. Section M-114.3, Fee schedule, shall read as follows:

"The fees for all mechanical work shall be as indicated in Section 114.3.1 of the BOCA Basic Building Code, Eleventh Edition, 1990 hereinafter set forth."
5. Section M-117.4 is hereby deleted.
6. Section M-118.2 is hereby deleted.

7. The provisions of Sections M-122.1 shall read as follows:

“Section M-122.1. Appeals. Any person aggrieved by any decision of the Building Inspector may appeal therefrom to the Board of Trustees. Said Board may affirm, modify or reverse the decisions of the Building Inspector. Thereupon, the Building Inspector shall take action in accordance with the decisions of said Board.”
8. Section 508.0 is hereby deleted.
9. Section M-1500.2 Annual inspection. All crematories and all incinerators, except Class I, Class 1A and domestic, may be inspected annually by the department. Fee for such inspection shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per incinerator or crematory.
